TYPICALLY FRENCH

Veuve Clicquot - The world famous Champagne, with the yellow label and an incredibly strong woman behind it all, Madame Clicquot. It was also the first Champagne house to produce a Rose Champagne. One of Bianca's favourites and good to pop out at any time. The brut is rich and creamy in style, with an explosion of citrus fruit and a delightful toasty finish.

The Rosé - a beautiful pink tinge, due to the Pinot Noir dominance. It's bursting with summer fruit characters.

Tattinger Brut Reserve - One of the most awarded wines in its region, Tattinger is synonymous with Champagne. The brut Reserve presents with fresh fruit and honey which makes it appealing to both old and new wine drinkers.

Bollinger Special Cuvee Brut - Bollinger is perfect shared among friends, for simple and/or meaningful moments. A subtle combination of structure, length and vivacity; bubbles like velvet; pear, brioche and spicy aromas, notes of fresh walnut.

BEAUTIFULLY BRITISH

Rathfinny (Sussex) - This family-owned estate was established in 2010 by Mark and Sarah Driver. Rathfinny's estate vineyard now extends to over 93 hectares in the South Downs. Rathfinny uses only estate-grown fruit for their four traditional-method sparkling wines: Classic Cuvée, Blanc de Blancs, Blanc de Noirs and Rosé. Each of their wines is produced and labelled as a vintage wine. We are proud to stock their whole range:

Classic Cuvee Brut - Refreshing and moreish, the aromas of grapefruit, red apple and brioche on the nose, complement the zesty acidity and creamy texture on the palate.

Blanc de Blancs - This 100% Chardonnay is pale lemon in colour with flecks of gold. Aromas of lemon curd, pastry and citrus blossom compliment the fine balance of acidity and creamy mouthfeel. The finish has hints of toast and hazelnuts.

Rosé Brut - This is everything you want in a sparkling rosé. Juicy and refreshing finish, which compliments its vivid coral hue. The aromas of cranberry, cherry blossom and red apple really work with the hints of brioche and pink grapefruit on the palate.

Blanc de Noirs - With a rose-gold glow, this Pinot Noir dominated sparkling delivers an expressive nose of baked Braeburn apples, a textured mousse of morello cherries, and a refined, plum-compote finish.

Welland Valley Steeple Chase (Market Harborough) - Welland Valley's flagship Blanc de Blanc Sparkling wine is made in the traditional bottle fermented way. A blend of the French Seyval Blanc and German Reichensteiner with a minimum of 3 years on the lees. It's light, with a hint of biscuit and a wonderful mousse.

Welland Valley Tickled Pink Rosé (Market Harborough) - Tickled Pink follows the fashionable trend towards lighter coloured and flavoured pinks. Bottle fermented in the traditional champagne method, this pink bubbly is brimming with flavours of summer berries and is pure delight in a glass.

PROSECCO, OUR USUAL SUSPECT

Ca' di Alte, Prosecco Spumante Extra Dry NV (Italy) - This Prosecco is a light straw yellow with fine bubbles. Aromas of pear and white flowers that follow onto a palate which is bright and clean with a refreshing finish.

BIANCA'S HOME COMFORTS

Graham Beck (South Africa) - Graham Beck's Brut NV is affectionately known as the 'President's Choice', as was served at both Nelson Mandela's inauguration and Barack Obama's presidential victory. Graham Beck's sparkling wines are some of South Africa's finest and most highly prized. Grapes are hand selected from the limestone-rich vineyards on this prestigious estate, and the wine is crafted using the Cap Classique (Champagne) method.

Brut - Light, toasty aromas, with lime fruit and refreshing ripe apple notes. Rich, creamy complexity on the palate, with an exceptionally fine mousse, real freshness and finesse.

Brut Rosé - This wine has a unique pale silver-pink hue. A lively mousse, but fine in the mouth, with subtle red berry flavours. Flirtatious and fun, yet elegant and structured. It's perfect for all seasons and settings.

Miraval, Rose (Côtes de Provence) - Brad Pitt & Angelina Jolie own this 100% organic vineyard. Beautiful, petal-pink colour with aromas of fresh redcurrants, rose and zesty lemon. A must try!

Gabrielskloof 'Rosebud' Rosé (South Africa) - A beautifully elegant and aromatic wine that has pronounced aromas of watermelon, papaya, white peach and grapefruit. The palate is juicy and dry, balanced perfectly by a refreshing acidity.

A Mano, Primitivo Rosato (Italy) - This wine is a vibrant pink colour, with youthful aromas of fresh cherries, tree-ripened peaches and cassis. The palate is structured and surprisingly full-bodied, balanced perfectly by zippy acidity and a fresh fruit character.

Casa Ferreirinha, 'Vinha Grande' Douro Rosé (Portugal) - A delicate pale pink colour. On the nose precise red fruit aromas of strawberry and cherry are coupled with hints of violet - a signature aroma of Touriga Nacional. A refreshing acidity on the palate carries the bright flavours onto the long, fresh finish.

RED WINE

COMFORTING AND FULL BODIED

Springfield Estate 'Whole Berry' (South Africa) - This cabernet has a full-throttle fruity style, with red and black fruit flavours to the fore, velvety tannins, and minty/spicy notes adding plenty of interest.

Springfield Estate 'The Work of Time' (South Africa) - A Bordeaux blend, deep and concentrated on the nose, opening up to reveal crisp cassis fruit with smoky edges on the palate. A hint of green pepper with a ripe firm structure.

Château Fleur de Lisse, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru (Bordeaux) - Aromas of vibrant red berries, blackberry fruit and liquorice spice, underpinned by elegant, fine-grained tannins and a lingering, fresh finish.

Nero d'Avola Conte Nero (Sicily) - The deep red colour of this wine compliments its well balanced, full body. Cassis, blackberry, raspberry, pepper and vanilla aromas accompany tart cherry and hints of dark chocolate on the palate.

THE USUAL SUSPECTS

Fairview Pinotage (South Africa) - The Pinotage grape is South Africa's signature variety and this Pinotage is bright ruby red in colour. Aromas of black cherries, plums with hints of dark chocolate, cinnamon and spice. Beautifully full bodied with a spicy finish.

Amalaya Malbec, Argentina - Everything you would expect from a Malbec. Aromas of strawberries, raspberries and ripe fruit. Flavours of red fruit, spice and hints of vanilla make this well rounded with has a delicate, lingering finish. Yum!

Dandelion Vineyards, 'Lion's Tooth of McLaren Vale' Shiraz/Riesling (Australia) - Deep red in colour with youthful violet hints, the wine has aromas of rose petals, lifted red fruits and a hint of lime marmalade from the co-fermentation with the aromatic Eden Valley Riesling. Wild cherries, blueberries and balanced, spicy oak make for an opulent palate, with velvety tannins and an intriguing finish.

De Loach 'Heritage Collection' Pinot Noir (California, USA) - An elegant and well-balanced Pinot Noir, offering juicy flavours of raspberry and strawberry, accented beautifully with a touch of white pepper. It is medium bodied in style with a bright and lingering finish.

El Coto, 'Coto de Imaz' Rioja Reserva, Spain - This wine is intense cherry in colour with a hint of ageing at the rim. On the nose, it has ripe red fruits accompanied by hints of cocoa from the new American oak. On the palate, the wine is velvety and round, with smooth tannins and good acidity. The finish is balanced and long.

THE 'WOW' FACTOR!

The Chocolate Block (South Africa) - One of Bianca & Chris' favourite South African Reds, it's something that you just need to try. Intense aromas of black cherries, cardamom, sweet tobacco, espresso and subtle whiffs of perfume. The palate is complex and juicy with gentle nuances of ripe plums, violets, black olives, cloves, and liquorice.

Crystallum 'Peter Max' Pinot Noir (South Africa) - This beautiful Pinot Noir has red and black fruits on the nose; wild strawberry and rhubarb work alongside blackberries and tomato leaf while black olives, salted liquorice and a signature charcuterie-like smokiness add gravitas. The palate is fresh, vibrant and precise, with red plum and sour cherry supported by a racy acidity and fine, pine-resin tannins.

Meerlust Rubicon (South Africa) - The Rubicon is a South African classic. It's made by the Meerlust estate, which has been in the Myburgh family since 1756. And it paved the way for the country's Bordeaux blends that are rightfully celebrated today. This has notes of black fruit, cedar, tobacco leaf and spice.

Tenuta San Guido Sassicaia (Tuscany, Italy) - Sassicaia is a wine known and loved the world over. From a beautiful coastal hamlet in Tuscany, this Super Tuscan blend is hands down Italy's most famous wine. It has typical ruby red colour and velvety tannins complemented by spice flavours and black currant aromas. It's juicy with a taste of black fruit and a hint of mint freshness on the palate. A real treat.

Antinori Tignanello (Tuscany, Italy) - The wine which led the way for the Super-Tuscan movement. The evolution of Tignanello represents a number of historic innovations for Italian wine: the first Sangiovese to be aged in French-style barriques, the first abandonment of the mandatory portion of white grapes in a Tuscan red wine blend and the first wine to adopt the non-native Cabernet Sauvignon. From 1971 to this day, Tignanello is 85% Sangiovese, with Cabernet varieties making up the remainder. It is a warm, velvety and inviting wine with an opulent palate that often boasts black cherries, spices, vanilla and tobacco, and smooth, silky tannins.

WHITE WINE

LIGHT AND BREEZY

Fairview Chenin Blanc (South Africa) - This Chenin Blanc is a pale straw colour with tropical aromas of pineapple and hints of citrus on the nose. The palate is fresh and crisp with lively acidity and flavours of lime and mineral hints on the long finish.

Corte Giara Pinot Grigio (Italy) - This wine is bright straw yellow in colour with light and delicate aromas showing a lovely Pinot Grigio character. Elegant floral notes are complemented by hints of ripe apples and distinctive herbal and characteristic hazelnut notes. This wine is dry, medium-bodied with a racy acidity and good depth.

Welland Phoenix (Market Harborough) - A small, beautiful Vineyard in Market Harborough that packs a punch. The Phoenix is a crisp, easy drinking white wine and a great introduction to English wine. Give it a go!

Brightwell Baccus (Oxfordshire) - This is a soft and fruity white wine with a natural fruit sweetness to balance its dry structure. The wine captures the aromatic flavours of the Bacchus grape in a gentle and easy drinking wine. Bacchus is a 'green fruit' wine similar to Sauvignon Blanc, and is superb with cheese.

Rothley Gundog (Leicestershire) - Clear, pale lemon colour. Aroma of asparagus and forest floor. Taste of ripe grapefruit with lime and a hint of sherbet. Tangy, giving a bite on the foretaste similar to a dry Riesling. Spicy notes of white pepper on a lingering aftertaste. A complex, musky wine that is crisp, refreshing.

Rothley Solaris (Leicestershire) - Pale lime colour. Aroma of pineapple and pear tingled with elderflower. The ripe grapefruit flavour merges with white currant and gooseberry to give a crisp and refreshing wine with good minerality on the lingering finish.

Alvarinho Reserva, Azevedo, Vinho Verde (Portugal) - Clear and bright yellow in colour. On the nose, the wine boasts intense aromas of nectarine, apricot and mango along with floral nuances. Full flavoured and rich on the palate but balanced by a lively acidity which carries the ripe fruit flavours onto the lingering finish.

CRISP AND COMPLEX

Southern Right Sauvignon Blanc (South Africa) - Named after the rare Southern Right whales that visit the nearby bay, in Cape Town, this wine is special for so many reasons. It is Old World in style with lovely defined minerality and purity. Prominent yellow apple, nectarine and lemon zest aromas with a particularly saline, mineral, chalky dry palate and lemon and quince flavours. The wine has a layered and textured coating to its dry mineral core and finishes bright, pure and long. And if you need any more reason to buy this fine South African wine, then it must be noted that for every bottle sold, the estate will donate to the conservation of the whales. That's just one of the reasons we love it so much.

Framingham Sauvignon Blanc (Marlborough, New Zealand) - This Sauvignon Blanc has smoky aromatics, with flint, bitter lemon citrus, grapefruit and tropical hints. The palate is rich with good mouthfeel, texture and harmony. Flavours of yellow citrus, currant, stone fruit and sweet herbs carry through the finish.

Mandarossa 'Costadune', Grillo (Sicily, Italy) - This wine is straw-yellow with green reflections. On the nose it is intense and vibrant with scents of fruits and Sicilian citrus fruits as loquat, prickly pear, grapefruit and notes of basil. On the palate it is fresh, intense and pleasant.

Izadi Rioja Blanco (Spain) - This wine is straw yellow in colour with youthful hues. With succulent citrus and yellow stone fruit on both the nose and the palate, this well-balanced wine has good structure and acidity.

NOW FOR SOMETHING A LITTLE DIFFERENT...

Franz Haas Gewürztraminer (Italy) - This is definitely something quite different, so if you are feeling adventurous give it a go ☺ The Gewürztraminer has an intense, golden yellow colour with a deep bouquet of complex aromas such as lychee, orange peel, cloves, nutmeg and rose. The palate is full and stimulating thanks to its structure, freshness and vivacity, with a slightly bitter and persistent final note. The Gewürztraminer achieves its complete evolution only after several months of aging in the bottle.

Hamilton Russel Chardonnay (South Africa) - Hamilton Russell wines are regarded as some of the best in South Africa. This Chardonnay is a lovely tropical, minerally South African style Chardonnay, with good fruit weight and real vibrancy. It is aged for 9 months in French oak, where it gains great structure and concentration.

Crystallum "The Agnes" Chardonnay (South Africa) - This is both a fuller bodied and more exotic vintage, showing white peach, papaya, jasmine and notable lemongrass on the nose. A palate of butterscotch and lemon curd is tart yet mouth-coating and cut by a stony, saline spine that keeps the wine taut and upright.

Blank Canvas, Marlborough Grüner Veltliner (Marlborough, New Zealand) - A wine of wonderful, pure aromatics this Grüner Veltliner exemplifies classic notes of mandarin, and tangelo with an underlying trace of black pepper. The subtle toast and cedar aromatics, from fermentation in 60% oak puncheon, fill out the savoury components and flesh out the middle palate. The result is a complex, rich and weighty rendition of an Austrian classic.

De Loach Chardonnay (California, USA) - This wine is pale straw yellow in colour with rich aromas of lime, white peach and baked apple pie. On the palate, flavours of nutmeg and a touch of caramel frame the vibrant acidity.
